Certified Accountant Technician (CAT) and Financial Management Diploma (FMD)

What is CBM?

CBM stands for College of Business and Management. It is a corporate body established in 2009 to conduct training leading to recognized professional qualifications in Business and Management discipline in Tanzania. The Purpose of founding CBM was to foster a learning environment that motivates students to make learning an on-going life-long process. CBM is a multi-dimensional educational institution, that wants to encourage students to personal development. Therefore the college provides its students with the skills to make ethically and effective decisions in business and other endeavors of life.

What is ACCA?

ACCA stands for Association of Chartered Certified Accountants. It is the global body for professional accountants. ACCA provides professional qualification in accountancy all over the world and therefore created a framework for recognition of qualification that can be adapted all everywhere.

ACCA works with governments, donor agencies and professional bodies such as the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) to develop the global accountancy profession and to advance the public interest. ACCA can look back to 100 years of experiences in promoting global standards and it aims to meet the current and future needs of international business.

ACCA provides different qualifications. Students can sit for an examinations paper based in December and June and computer based all over the year. To prepare students best for these examinations CBM decided to provide tuition for two ACCA programs:

1. Certified Accountant Technician
2. Financial Management Diploma

For both courses the application deadline is the 15th December 2010 and the courses will start in January.

Certified Accountant Technician (CAT)

The program consist of one year study and one year practical experience in the workplace. Afterwards the student will be able to perform an accounting-support role. The CAT also enable students for further studies.

Entry requirements

We at CBM require students who passed secondary school, but basically everybody can study CAT.

- Implementing Audit Procedures (two out of three)
- Preparing Taxation Computations (two out of three)
- Managing Finances (two out of three)

Financial Management Diploma

This one-year program aims to create a financial awareness and to achieve a level of practical understanding that is genuinely useful in the workplace. It was created to give managers the chance to develop skills comparable to accountants. Managers are enabled to link financial information to broader strategic decisions.

Entry Requirements

The minimum entry requirement for the Diploma is a recognised degree, higher national certificate/diploma or a non-accounting professional qualification. Its also possible that people get admitted based on their work experiences, then the applicant has to demonstrate that the diploma is needed for its work.
